Guidelines

- ◆ Nominees for the SSD Key to the Classroom/Teacher of the Year Award must be classroom teachers who are employed by SSD during the current school year. These guidelines are based on the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's (DESE) Teacher of the Year criteria. SSD Teacher of the Year will be the District's candidate for DESE's regional and state competitions.
- ◆ In accordance with region and state guidelines, SSD will select a dedicated and highly-skilled candidate capable of inspiring students of all backgrounds and abilities.
- ◆ Because the Missouri Teacher of the Year will be asked to speak on behalf of all state educators, the candidate must be poised, articulate and energetic.
- ◆ Individuals can be nominated by SSD staff, parents, students, partner district staff or community member.
- ◆ Maximum of two nominators per form.
